Recede / Reseed
- Question 6** Shows disapproval / Alcohol
Boos / Booze
- Question 7** The intended victim of a swindler / A brand or product, particularly of a car.
Mark / Marque
- Question 8** An Eastern person / Item of clothing
Thai / Tie
- Question 9** Condiment / Called a group together.
