Question 3 Born 1933, best known as Gunner "Lofty" Sugden in It Ain't Half Hot Mum. Had a hit in 1975 with a version of "Whispering Grass", sung with Windsor Davies

Don Estelle

Question 4 Born 1965, Canadian singer and actress, whose hits include "That Don't Impress Me Much", and "Man - I Feel Like a Woman"

Shania Twain

Question 5 Born 1958, Italian opera singer who went blind at 15 years old due to glaucoma

Andrea Bocelli

Question 6 Born 1941, British fashion designer best known for her punk and new wave fashions. Owns a number of high street outlets in her name, and known for her support of environmental groups

Vivienne Westwood

Question 7 Born 1959, English actress, known for her role as Sharon in the comedy series Birds of a Feather, which also starred Linda Robson & Lesley Joseph

Pauline Quirk

Question 8 Born 1943 and 1940, two members of the Beatles

Question 9 Born 1903, American singer known for his collaborations with Bob Hope, starring in the "Road to..." films from 1940 to 1962
